1st call for applications for Short-Term Scientific Missions

The call is open to all **CIRCUL'ARTs-CA23117** members, but young researchers¹ are generally the primary target group.

Note that this first call is open for applications till **July 20, 2025**.

The grants available are destined for attaining and working with a CIRCUL'ARTs-Trainer, during the 3 Training Schools (that have each the duration of 1-day). These will take place in person respectively between 8th -10th of September at FMSH in Paris (<https://www.fmsch.fr/en>). The STSM grants have the objective of producing a reflection on the activities developed during the Training School and making respectively a profile of each one of the 3 Trainers, who are ground breaking personalities in their field and innovative practitioners in transdisciplinary fields.

The STSM grantee is expected to deliver an output in the form of an academic research (article, book chapter, commented interview with the Trainer) or artistic research (film, photo, video work or mixed media). The grantee's production should represent an overview of the Trainer's theoretical approach, the methodologies developed during the Training School and the Trainer's overall innovative vision. The grantee's output will be integrated into the production of the COST Action CIRCUL'ARTs and disseminated on the website and in the print production of the project.

The deadline for the presentation of the output is 10 months after the end date of the grant. In particular, the grantee's stay in Paris should end by the 12th of September to be sure all necessary documents can be processed before the end of the 1st CIRCUL'ARTs year.

This 1st Action Year, it is estimated that 3-5 STSM could be funded from the Action's budget. When writing your application, consider how it fits into the CIRCUL'ARTs framework and which topics you'll help to push forward.

In any case, your stay at the host institution should be beneficial and should contribute to the success of the Action CA23117.
